

General Set of Guidelines for the Participants

I. ***Transport arrangements made for the participants to reach BMU for the 49th AISC***

BMU will provide pick-up and drop-off facility from IFFCO Chowk Metro Station of the Delhi Metro ([Yellow line](#)). Please fill this [google form](#) to give your travel pick-up preference. Pick-up will be available on 21st and 22nd of December. Drop-off is provided for 24th December 2024. You are requested to arrive at the pick-up location as per your itinerary and the available pick-up slots.

You will be provided with a transport coordinator's phone number nearer to the conference dates.

If your travel plan does not match the pick-up and drop-off facilities provided, please refer to the next section to get information to help you plan your own travel to BMU.

II. ***Ways to Reach BML Munjal University (BMU), Kapriwas, Gurugram, Haryana (own transportation)***

Travelling by train: Nearest Train Stations: Rewari Junction (NW Railway), New Delhi Railway Station, Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station.

1. Rewari Junction: Rewari Junction is 32 kms away from BMU campus. You can take a cab/ taxi/ auto from the train station to the campus.
2. New Delhi Railway Station: New Delhi Railway Station is 70 kms away from BMU campus.
 - a) You can take a private cab/ taxi from the train station to the campus.
 - b) You can take the Metro – Yellow Line to reach IFFCO Chowk. BMU will have a shuttle service from IFFCO metro station stop to campus.
 - c) You can take the Haryana Roadways Bus from IFFCO Chowk Metro station which leaves every 15 minutes. You will need to get down at BMU stop or the Raman Munjal Vidya Mandir School stop (inform the conductor)
3. Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station This railway station is 75 kms away from BMU campus.
 - a) You can take a private cab/ taxi from the train station to the campus.
 - b) You can take the Metro – Pink Line – to Delhi Cantt and then take a Haryana Roadways Bus to BMU campus.

Travelling by Air: Nearest Airport: 1. Indira Gandhi International Airport (T1, T2, T3)

The airport is about 56 kms away from BMU campus.

- a) You can take a private taxi/ cab from the airport to the campus.
- b) You can take the IGI Airport Metro – “Airport Express Metro” – to Dhaula Kuan Metro Stop. From here you can take a cab or any Haryana Roadways bus to campus. You can get down at the BMU stop or the Raman Munjal Vidya Mandir School stop (inform the conductor)

Travelling by Road:

1. Private cab/ vehicle: Please check google maps for directions from your location.

2. Via Bus: Inter-state buses run every 20-30 minutes from Dhaula Kuan bus stand towards Gurugram. The nearest bus stop to campus is ‘Mahaveer Chowk’ (also known as ‘Gaushala Ground’), situated about an 11 minutes walking distance from the campus. However, you can also request the bus conductor to stop for you in front of BMU or Raman Munjal Vidya Mandir School (they are adjacent to each other).

III. *Managing Your Stay in BML Munjal University Campus:*

- Please carry your necessary documents for identification at the time of on-site registration and allotment of accommodations (including Aadhar Card/Voter ID/Passport and the Gate Pass or confirmation mail from the AISC Conference Team about your participation in the conference). Student delegates must additionally carry their university ID cards with them.
- Research Committee session schedule will be shared with you closer to the date of the conference. Please contact your respective RC Convenor if you any special request for scheduling your presentation.
- A technical support team will be present to assist you with your presentation. The schedule of your presentation will be shared before the Conference dates. It is highly recommended that you carry a backup of your presentation on a USB drive ,e-mail, etc. If you are carrying Apple MacBooks, please carry your own Type C to HDMI adapter/cable for connecting your device to the projectors.
- The month of December gets extremely cold in Delhi-NCR. Participants are advised to bring adequate warm clothing for themselves. The accommodations do not have provision for heating, but blankets and linen will be provided by the organizing team. The bathrooms have geysers and hot water dispensers will be available on the ground floor of your residence.
- There is a small dispensary within the university campus for managing minor medical emergencies. Please carry essential medicines that you think are appropriate and may be required by you.
- To avoid any health risks due to the depleted air quality in the region, it is advisable to use N95 masks during your stay in the campus. For those participants with any respiratory illnesses, it is also recommended that you carry your prescribed inhalers for emergency purposes.

-The university campus has ATM machines within the campus which will be accessible to the delegates. There are small tuck shops for your daily essentials inside the campus as well, but we recommend that you bring your own toiletries.

- University shuttle services will be provided for commute from IFFCO Chowk Metro Station to the Campus at the time of arrival before the conference and departure after the conference only. The delegates can avail cab services for their personal use during the stay in the campus at their own expenses. Online service providers including Ola, Uber and others have their service to BMU.

- You will be staying in the student hostels within BMU campus. BMU is a tobacco, alcohol and drug free campus. Please ensure that you follow the University disciplinary codes and state regulations related to staying inside an educational institution in India.

- You will be allotted your room at the time of your registration. Please note that to get the room allocation, the registered participant must be physically present at the registration counter. Proxy registration is not allowed.

- You will have access to internet on campus.
