## **Keynote Speaker**



Dr. Sudhir Krishnaswamy is the Vice-Chancellor of NLSIU, Bengaluru and the Director of the Distance Education Department, NLSIU. He is also the co-founder and trustee of the not for profit research trust, Centre for Law and Policy Research. Previously, he was the Director of the School of Policy and Governance, and Professor of Law and Politics at Azim Premji University.

A Rhodes Scholar and graduate of Oxford University, he has earlier worked with the Prime Minister's Committee on Infrastructure, Planning Commission; and the Kasturi Rangan Expert Committee on Bangalore Governance. His main areas of interest are constitutional law, Legal System Reform, legal theory, intellectual property law and administrative law. He has also written on a wide range of topics, including Indian constitutional law, intellectual property law, and judicial corruption.

Sudhir is also part of Facebook's oversight board that was set up to moderate content posted on social media platforms. He is the only Indian among the 20 members of the board that comprises independent Members from around the world. The board has the power to make decisions on content that can be allowed or removed from Facebook and Instagram.

He served as Head of the Economics Department of the DSE from 2014 to 2018, and is currently Executive Director of the Department's research adjunct, the Centre for Development Economics.

He earlier taught for many years at St. Stephen's College, Delhi (1980-96), and has been a visiting associate professor at Duke University, USA, and a Shastri Indo-Canadian Faculty Research Fellow at the University of British Columbia, Canada. His research interests include competition (antitrust) law, economics, and policy; labour market regulation; and trade policy under imperfect competition. His articles have appeared in leading law and economics journals in India and abroad.
